E. Other Business

Update on Health & Physical Education Curriculum (HPEC)

- x In response to a question on the status of the HPEC Mazzorato stated that the Board is awaiting final approval from the Bishops on the strand on Human Growth and Sexual Health before it can be taught in Dufferin/Peel schools.
- x All HPEC human growth and sexual health expectations will be met through Fully Alive program. Teachers will use the material that has been provided by the Institute for Catholic Education (ICE) to teach this strand;
- x Schools are encouraged to contact Shelagh Peterson, Coordinator, Religious Education & Faith Formation, to help address some of the concerns the community may have regarding this curriculum. S. Peterson will be invited by the CCCSC to do a presentation on this subject during this school year;
- x As has always been the practice of this board, letters will be sent to parents around sensitive areas to give them advance notice of what will be taught in the classroom and to give them the opportunity to follow-up with their child at home and answer any questions the child may have;
- x Parent information pamphlets on HPEC have been developed;
- x Model lessons will also be made available for parental review in advance of being introduced in the classroom;
- x Teachers will be provided with their own copy of all resources required to teach the revised HPEC. They also have access to consultants at the Board who can assist them where needed.
