

Capital Priorities

On an annual basis the Ministry of Education requests submissions from school boards identifying their top capital construction priority needs through a Capital brities funding request submission. School boards have an opportunity to submit up to a maximum of eight (8) business cases identifying the highest and most urgent pupil accommodation needs a Board of Trustees is required to approve the list of capital priorities for submission. Subject to Board approval staff files a Capital Priorities form for each approved project, in addition to preparing a business case in support of each priority. Both the Capital Priorities form and the business cases provide a scope of work, enrolment information, development information, existing accommodation situation, renewal and facility condition data, new child care needs and other relevant information supporting the request.
