2. Trustee Mario Pascucci: Can you provide a status of decisions made regarding September start up?

Director Mazzorato: Council of Ontario Directors of Education (CODE) has impressed upon the Ministry of Education (Ministry) that direction is needed regarding learning modes and options, and we hope to have more information within the coming weeks. Secondary school staff are now in the process of planning and timetabling for the 2021-2022 school year. Similar to the model used in September 2020, secondary classes will be organized in a Quadmester delivery model (i.e., two courses per ten-week cycle) for at least the first semester of school until the end of January. At the elementary level we are to structure class sizes according to regulation size.
