## CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT RESOURCE MANUAL

As stated in 2016 (OS) Students must complete a minimum of 40 hours of community involvement activities

### GENERAL INFORMATION

### GRADUATION REQUIREMENT

Every student must complete a minimum of forty (40) hours of community involvement activities as a graduation requirement.

Though the forty hours of recognized service can be accomplished in one year, the DufferinPeel Catholic District School Board hopes that students will opt for involvement in more than one activity over two or more years. It is further hoped that studentswill become interested in service to others, and exceed the minimum requirement.

#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the requirement is to foster an understanding of civic responsibility; to develop a student's sense of worth as they play a role in their community; and to help young people develop their skills.

#### TIMING

The work to fulfill this requirement can begin at any time after a student has graduated from grade 8. A single forty-hour activity, or a series of shortterm activities totaling forty hours must be completed. The student must submit evidence of their community service hours, as per the process provided at their school.

#### **GETTING STARTED**

#### STEP #1

Students under the age of eighteen should plan an activity in consultation with their parent(s)/guardian(s). The activity should be one that involves service to others. The activity must fall within the guiding principles the DufferiPeel Catholic Distric School Board has establish dudents 18 years of age and older do not need to consult with his/her parent(s)/guardian(s).

#### STEP #2

#### **INELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES**

The Ministry of Education and Training has developed a list of activities that may NOTbe chosen as community involvement activities and that are, therefore, INELIGIBLE ACTIVITIESAn ineligible activity is an activity that:

The following guiding principles, read in conjunction with the list of ineligible activities, are intended to assist the studentandparent(s)/guardian(s) determine whether aplanne dectivity is within an approve dereafor the completion of the Community Involvementequirement:

An event or activity performed with the community as an expressification

An event or activity designed to be of benefit todbemunity.

An event or activity to support a nfotr-profit agency, institution or foundation that conforms to the ethical andreligious standards of the DufferPreel Catholic District School Board and the MinistryEofucation.

Any structure drogram that promote stutoring, mentoring, visiting or coaching or whose purposes to assist others who require the benefit of t

Participation in an event or activity that promotes positive environmentarieness.

Participation in an event or activity that promotes positive inclusivity of all persons and contributes to the health and welbeing of all members of the community, including schoolsedactivities.

Participation in an event or activity affiliated with a club, religious organization, arts or cultural association, or political organization that is inclusive of our Catholic values and makes positive contribution to the community.

Where an event or activity does not clearly fall within the guidelines, the principle student's school has the discretion to approve or reject any activity or event that does not conform to the guiding principles and ethical standards for approved areas of involvement for students. Areas of involvement may include:

Fundraising- includescanvassing, walke-thons, celebrity games, gift wrapping, gala events and sales for charitable purposes.

Sports/Recreation includes coaching, helping to organize special meets and games, and volunteering as a leisure buddy or poddssistant.

Community Events-includes helping to organize winter carnivals, parades and sufrainser

#### Please Note

In the eventthata studentwould like to participate an activity or eventthatis not clearly within the Board's list of examples, the student must submit a letter detailing the proposed activity or nature of the participation and event to the student's Principal. The Principal, in conswitation the appropriate supervisory officer, will determine if the student's propose activity is acceptable. The activity or event should not be undertaken until permission has been granted. If completed without permission and permission is subsequently enied, the activity or event will not be counted toward the student's community involvement until permission.


Please note that a Principal is not obligated to approve a project at the local level.

Retreats are not neligible activity to count toward community service hour requirements.

Events or activities that may be based on or with a particular interest group must conform tethical and principled standards of the DufferiReel Catholic District School Board and the Ministry of Education and Training to ensure that they are intended to promote a positive contribution to the community in general.

Parent(s)/guardian(s) are responsible for ensuring that the selected placement is both safe and appropriate for the son/daughter.
