Vaccines required to attend school in Ontario All children attending primary and secondary school in Peel are required under the Immunization of School Pupils Act (ISPA)to be immun ized against the diseases outlined a _ p U N - I a wwebsideN Parrents or guardians must submit immunization records for these diseases or valid exemption documents

to Peel Public Health. These vaccines are available through primary care provider s (i.e., family doctor, nurse practitioner), and as of April 1, they are also available through Peel Public Health maccine clinics free of charge, by

appointment only.

These clinics are intended to help school-aged children and their families with challenges accessing primary care services. Afternoon, evening and Saturday appointments can be booked by calling 905-799-7700, Caledon residents 905-584-2216.

Except for the mening ococcal vaccine, please note that the vaccines given as part of ISPA are not part of Peel Public Health \$\bar{s}\$ in-school vaccination program for Grades 7&8 which provides immunizations for mening ococcal, hepatitis B, and HPV. These vaccines are also available through Peel Public Health clinics and can be book ed online.
