St. Anne will operate as a separate school within the host school buildings. The bell times for the schools will be offset, to minimize traffic congestion at the beginning and end of the school day. The daily operation of St. Anne within St. Ursula and St. Angela Merici will be coordinated ther minimize disruptions. This includes effet times for recess, lunch, gym and library. There will be minimal interactions between the schools. Before and after school care will continue to be provided for St. Anne students at the host locations.
